



Directions:

Upper Basildon is a small village laying to the west of Reading in Berkshire. These directions use main, well sign posted roads wherever possible.

From the north:

The A423 runs south-east from Oxford to Wallingford, then the A329 runs south from Wallingford, through Streatley to Pangbourne. After the entrance to Basildon House on the right, take the next right into Mead Lane. This is a single track road. Woodgreen Farm Buildings are half a mile along on the right just after the speed limit signs. If you miss Mead Lane carry on into Pangbourne and follow the directions from Reading, below.

From the south:

Take the A340 that runs north from Basingstoke (M3 Junction 6) to Pangbourne; crossing the A4 south of the M4* west of Junction 12. As you enter Pangbourne the road narrows considerably. Immediately before the 'Cross Keys' public house turn sharp left by Saint James the Less Church into Pangbourne Hill. Continue up the hill and into open countryside. At the first fork bear right. As you enter Upper Basildon take the right fork at Saint Stephen's Parish Church and continue on Pangbourne Road. Continue past 'The Beehive' public house, then right into Blandy's Lane. As you continue along this lane you will see a white, thatched cottage at the junction with Mead Lane. Turn right and, after a short distance, turn left into Woodgreen Farm Buildings. The office is immediately in front of you.

From the west:

Leave the M4 at Junction 12 and take the A4 toward Newbury. At the second roundabout take the exit for the A340 to Pangbourne. Then follow the directions from the south*.

From the east:

Leave the M4 at Junction 12 and take the A4 toward Newbury. At the second roundabout take the exit for the A340 to Pangbourne. Then follow the directions from the south*.

From Reading:

Take the A329 Oxford Road to Pangbourne. At the mini-roundabout by the 'Copper Inn' turn left into Church Street then first right by Saint James the Less Church into Pangbourne Hill. Continue up the hill and into open countryside. At the first fork bear right. As you enter Upper Basildon take the right fork at Saint Stephen's Parish Church and continue on Pangbourne Road. Continue past 'The Beehive' public house, then right into Blandy's Lane. As you continue along this lane you will see a white, thatched cottage at the junction with Mead Lane. Turn right and, after a short distance, turn left into Woodgreen Farm Buildings. The office is immediately in front of you.

By rail:

Pangbourne is on the main London to Bristol line. Taxicabs are available at the station or a PUSH staff member will collect you.
